

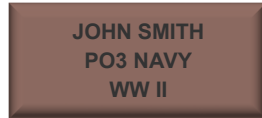


## Veterans Pavers

Engraved paver stones are available to honor any U.S. Veteran, past or present who provided honorable military service.

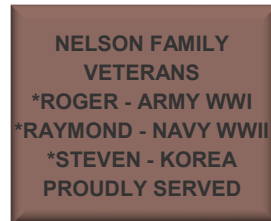
### 4x8 inch Single Veteran Paver

- ◆ Includes name of veteran, military rank or branch of service, years served or conflict. (3 lines/18 characters per line--including spaces)



### 8x8 inch Veteran, Group and Commercial Pavers

- ◆ Includes Veteran's organizations such as: Disabled American Veteran's Chapter 2, American Legion Post 39, Amvets, NSPFD, Pearl Harbor Survivors, etc. (6 lines/18 characters per line--including spaces) and Logo or Honorarium



## Placement & Replacement

Pavers are placed randomly in the three red striped areas, or may be requested to be side-by-side or in rows with other pavers of family or comrades. Written special requests will be considered by the Veteran's Park organization. Veteran's Park is responsible for replacing cracked pavers.

## Donations & Planned Giving

All donations are welcomed to support the park. Three premium levels of private and public support have been established for recognition in addition to the pavers.

Levels include:

- Gold - \$1000
- Silver - \$500
- Bronze - \$250
